**Jakub J. - Tricolored bat
(Perimyotis subflavus)**

1. Wingspan 8-9 inches, weight 0.3 oz.
2. Eats Mosquitos and other insects.
3. Mates in the fall, hibernates in winter, fertilizes eggs in the spring, has offspring (1-2) in the summer. In severe decline due to fungal disease.



Anonymous - Hoary Bat

- Has a wingspan of 15-16 inches.
- It weighs up to nearly an ounce.
- It's one of the largest North American bats.



Ken D. - Big Brown Bat

1. Some of the insects it consumes are agricultural pests like cucumber beetles.
2. Their breeding season is in the fall, shortly before hibernation.
3. They often produce 1 offspring and live about 6.5 years.
